We hope that you can take this list and along with any other items you can think of, prepare an emergency kit for your family. These items should be separate from other items normally used by your family and be readily accessible in case of emergency. Like the Boy Scouts, we hope that you can also, "Be Prepared!"

- Kit
- Large trash can w/wheels
  - Pack and run list  
(what else to grab if you have only minutes to pack)
  - AM Radio (battery or solar powered)
  - Home inventory (for insurance purposes)
  - Large Plastic Bags
  - Safety evacuation plan
  - 72 hour food/clothing kit  
(This list!)
  - Emergency Money
  - Spare flashlight(s)
  - Extra batteries
  - Tent(s) / tarps for shelter

- First Aid
- Emergency contact numbers
  - First aid kit (fully stocked)
  - First aid book/manual
  - Poison Control # \_\_\_\_\_
  - First aid kit (in car)
  - Essential Medications

- Food
- 72 hour water supply  
(min. 1 gallon/person/day)
  - Non-electric portable cooking stove
  - Extra fuel for stove
  - Matches / Lighters
  - Food (packaged or canned)
  - Household Bleach
  - Aluminum foil
  - Paper plates and cups
  - Plastic eating utensils
  - Paper towels
  - Can opener (non-electric)

- Hygiene
- Bar soap and detergent
  - Shampoo
  - Toothpaste/Toothbrush each
  - Feminine, Infant Supplies
  - Toilet Paper
  - Towels and washcloths

- Home
- Water-heater secured against earthquake
  - CO Detector in home
  - Smoke detector on each floor
  - Fire extinguisher - kitchen
  - Fire extinguisher in garage
  - Fire extinguisher in car(s)

- Tools
- Gas emergency shut off wrench
  - Knife, screwdriver, pliers, hammer
  - Ax, shovel and broom
  - Garden hose
  - Coil of 1/2" rope
  - Duct tape

- Personal
- Blankets/Sleeping Bag per person
  - Extra prescription glasses
  - Toys for kids
